


## How do I know what registration process should I follow?



<sup>1</sup>If you want to register your cattle you need to have them DNA typed to prove their ancestry (their parentage) and to be use to prove future ancestry of their progeny. NAA cannot accept registration applications for cattle that have not been DNA typed. You can find details of how to DNA type your cattle here.

<sup>2</sup>Foundation Pure are cattle with full registered pedigree records which trace the ancestry of the animal back to the original introduction of Nadudana into Australia.
