NAA Stud Breeders Charter

Introduction

The NAA's mission is to promote the Nadudana breed in Australia and to ensure its future integrity and quality. In line with this NAA has a stud registration system whereby breeders of Nadudana can be certified as sources of quality cattle by the Association. This document identifies the criteria whereby breeders can be considered for certification and identifies the principles that registered stud breeders will follow in the form of a stud breeders charter.

Criteria for consideration as a Registered Breeder of Nadudana

The following are the criteria that breeders need to meet prior to applying for registration of their stud.

1. Registered studs will have at least one Main registered (i.e. Foundation Pure) Nadudana
2. Have the capacity to produce cattle that can qualify for the NAA Main register (i.e. Foundation Pure) or Appendix register (50-87.5% registered Nadudana genetics)
3. Are willing and able to sell registered Nadudana cattle
4. Are willing to conduct their Nadudana breeding in full compliance with the Breeders' Charter

Failure to follow the Breeders Charter may result in loss or non-renewal of stud registration

The Breeders Charter

As an NAA certified Nadudana stud breeder I pledge to:

- Abide by the Members Rules of the NAA
- Always conduct my breeding with a view to the NAA's mission and vision and will, through that breeding, strive to maintain and improve the quality of Australian Nadudana in accordance with the breed standard
- Promote the NAA in my dealings with current and potential owners of Nadudana cattle
- Maintain a positive attitude about the Association, the Committee, its Members and when speaking with potential new members or owners of the breed
- DNA type, verify and register all my cattle before sale so that I can provide certified evidence of their pedigree to future buyers
- Fully declare to the buyers and explain the registration type of any Nadudana cattle I sell and be willing to explain the strengths and weakness of the cattle in relation to the breed standard
- When selling Nadudana cattle I will provide to the buyer, full documentation on the breeding history of the animal including registration certificates, registration numbers and DNA case numbers & certificates with written permission to access all of the above without hinderance
- Submit all births and deaths each year on renewal of my Full Membership with current herd records to the NAA Registrar to ensure continuity of my Stud Registration
- Encourage owners and buyers of Nadudana cattle to join NAA
